UCC Rules for Cart Use

Skip this side if you do not need a cart.
All players using carts must have a Cart Use Bag Tag.

Union Country Club is a walking course, but a few carts are available for those who would not be able to play without one. Cart users must sign and return the cart use form. A fee is charged to help cover the cost of fuel and cart maintenance.

- Carts are for the use of members only. Non-members may ride with an authorized member.
- To defray the cost of fuel, repairs, and other maintenance on our carts, a usage fee has been initiated. Those who fit the criteria for cart usage (see below) must pay an annual fee of **\$50.00**.
- The carts are reserved for persons who have difficulty walking. Persons who are physically able to walk should do so.
- *Carts cannot be reserved before hand; they are available on a first come first serve basis.*
- Persons under the age of 18 shall not drive carts unless accompanied by an adult.
- When driving the carts, be careful. Treat them with respect, they are older models and are “delicate”. To help prolong their existence: no speeding, quick turns or sudden stops. This is true especially when going over bumps and uneven terrain.
- Keep carts away from greens and tee areas; travel in rough whenever possible to minimize impact on fairways.
- *Alcoholic beverages may not be carried on or consumed by persons who are using carts.*
